- Chief Gillman to speak on monthly Police Report *Report is not ready due to personnel being on vacation.*
- Library had 66 visitors *Library hosted a multi day book sale*
- Scare crow competition is running from Oct 1<sup>st</sup> Oct 31st. *No discussion*
- GMEBS open enrollment is coming up starting in November. *No discussion*

- Ashley Wilson Act. House Bill 451 (Haley Black) HB451 will go into effect January 2025. The city must now offer PTSD claim coverage for first responders. The additional cost will be added into the GIRMA annual premium for the police officers.

## New Business

- 1. *Update Tate Park Rental Guidelines-* Motion made by Marci Mock and seconded by Steve Fain to set a Food Vendor rental fee of \$25 for food vendors to rent Tate Park. 3 parking spots will be designated at the back of the park for the vendors to set up/park. They will have access to the restrooms and water. All in favor, motion passed.
- 2. *Police SOP.* -<u>Motion made by Steve Fain and seconded by Marci Mock to approve the new police SOP (Standard Operating Procedures). All in favor, motion carried.</u>
- 3. *Whistleblower Policy*. Motion made by Billy Mauldin and seconded by Steve Fain to approve the Whistle Blowers Policy. All in favor, motion passed.
- 4. *Building Permit Fees* Motion made by Steve Fain and seconded by Bily Mauldin to approve the change of the formula the City uses to determine building permit fees. All in favor, motion passed. The new fee schedule will go into effect January 1, 2025. This amendment changed the building permit fee evaluation only, all other mechanical and standalone permit fees remain as is.
- 5. *Internal Affairs* Mayor asked for the budgeted expense set for city administrator position be moved to the salary for Chief of Police. Motion made by Marci Mock and seconded by Billy Mauldin to table request until a full council is present.
- 6. *2024 Christmas Parade*-Motion made by Steve Fain and seconded by Billy Mauldin to host the 2024 Christmas Parade Saturday December 7<sup>th</sup>. All in favor, motion passed.
